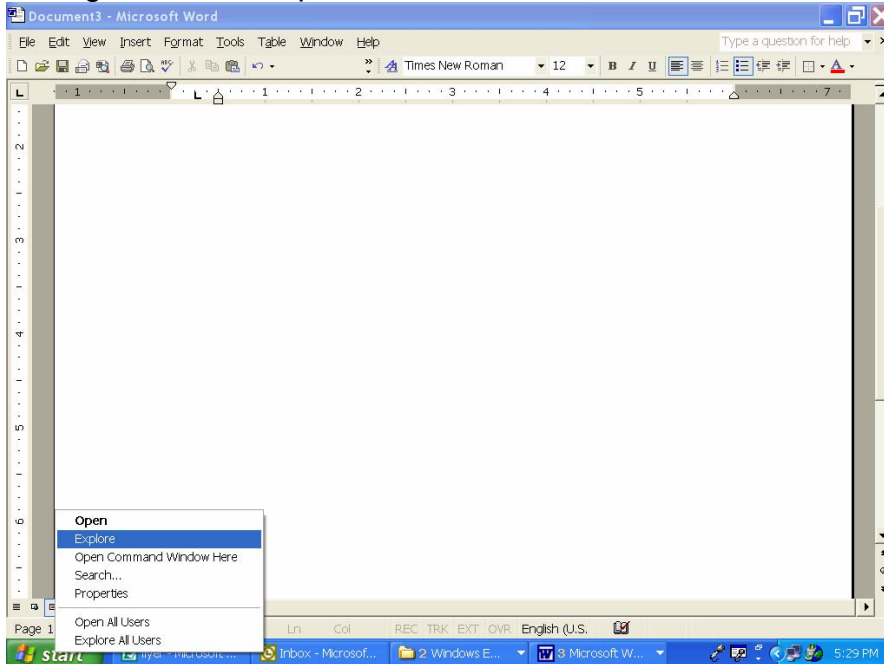


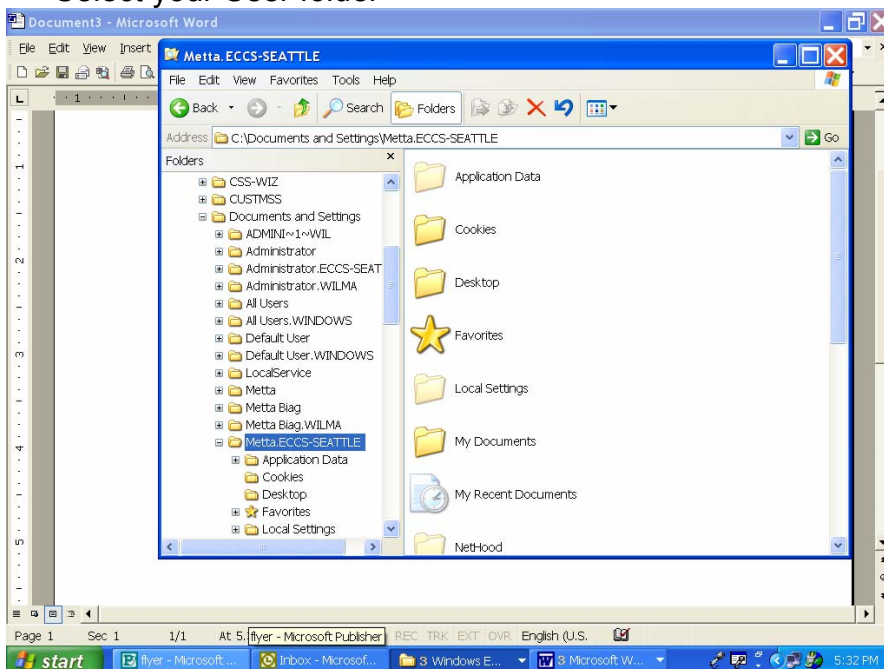


## HOW TO CLEAN OUT TEMPORARY DIRECTORIES (FOR WINDOWS 2000 and XP USERS)

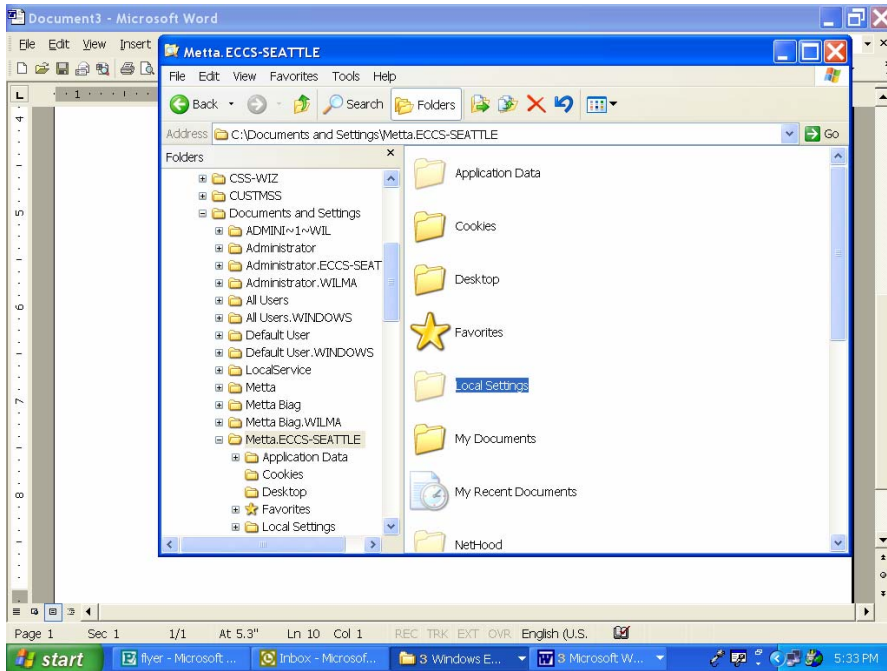
- Left click on Start menu
- Right Click on Explorer



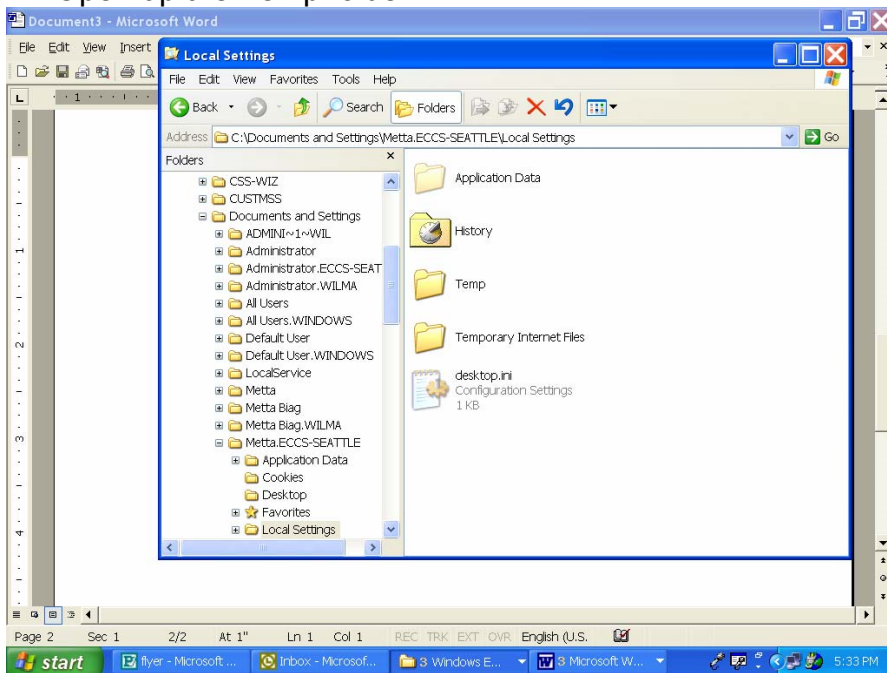
- Select Documents and Settings (For Windows 2000 and XP)
- Select your User folder



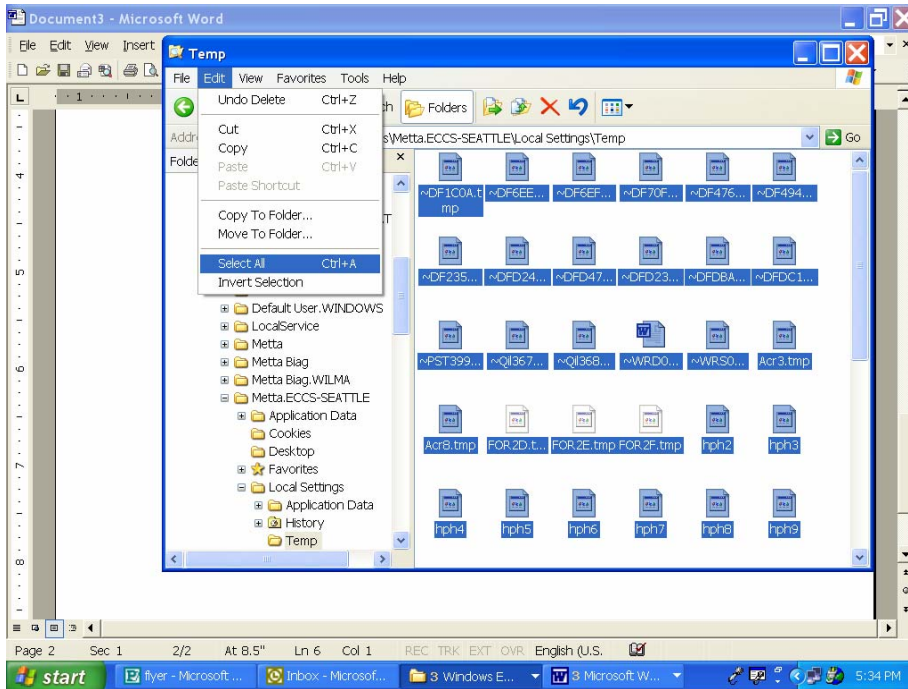
- On the right side select the Local Setting folder



- Open up the Temp folder



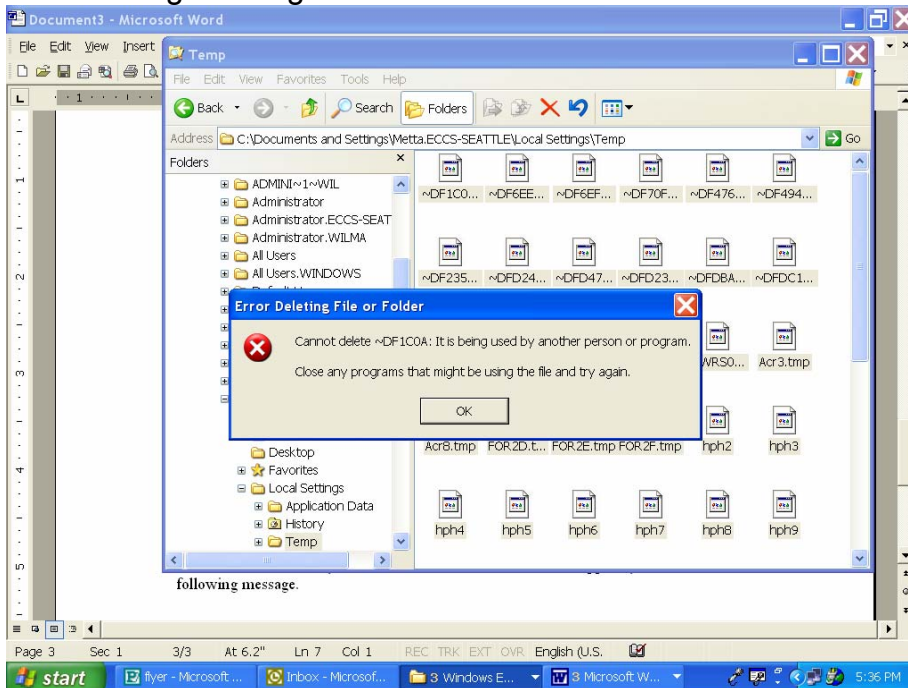
- In the Temp folder select Edit
- And select all (the files on the right side become highlighted)



- Select delete

NOTE:

Files which are currently in use can not be deleted, when this happens you will see the following message.



- Select OK
- Press down on the Ctrl button and at the same time select the file referenced in the error box, this box will become unchecked.
- Select delete key again.

You may need to do the Ctrl button thing many times before you are able to clean out the folder.

When done select the Temporary Internet Files folder and follow the same steps as before to clear at this directory.
